2011 T-Ball Rules

- 1. Kids that will be five years old by Aug 1 (starting kindergarten) shall be eligible to play in the T-Ball.
- 2. All players are allowed to play defense in the field. All players must play 1 inning in the infield prior to anyone playing a 2nd inning in the infield.
- 3. The outfield is defined as the grass area beyond the infield.
- 4. Batting order will be continuous in the same order each inning.
- 5. Coaches may be on the field, coaching players, while the game is in play. Tball is about teaching and learning.
- 6. Games will consist of 7 innings OR 1 hour game time. 4 runs will count as 1 inning OR 3 outs.
- 7. Each player will get 5 swings or 5 fouls to hit the ball then the player will be out.
- 8. Pitcher must stay in middle of pitching circle until ball is hit.
- 9. No stealing or leaving the base until ball is hit or dead ball will be called and runner will go back to the previous base.
- A player must have control of the ball in the infield for runner to stop running.
- Batter will be called out if the bat is thrown, after 1 warning per team.
